

Kitchen Spoon Scrubber



Materials

1 8.3-inch Rubber Spatula
Red Heart Scrubby Sparkle yarn
US 5 Straight needles
Yarn needle

I know the title of the pattern is “Kitchen Spoon Scrubber” and you are using a rubber spatula, but I got a gift similar to this that used a wooden spoon with the scrubby yarn crocheted around it. I prefer the rubber handle on the spatula because it is less slippery, and I was able to buy them in bulk on Amazon. A set of 8 for \$7.99. Kitchen Spoon Scrubber just sounds better than Kitchen Spatula Scrubber 😊

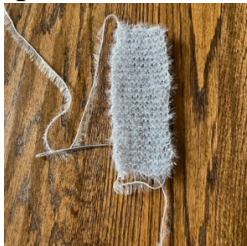

Directions

Pray for the love of Jesus to be stirred in the person's heart who will be receiving this gift as well as for them to stir the love of Jesus to those around them.

Cast-on 10 stitches. Try and leave about a 10-inch tail

Knit until your piece measures 4.5-5 inches. Stretch the piece over the top of the spatula to make sure it covers it.



Bind off leaving about a 10-inch tail. Fold the piece in half. Sew up each side. Turn it inside out and slip on the top of the spatula. You can either use a new piece of yarn to sew up the bottom or if enough left from sewing one of the sides, you can weave it down to the bottom and use that to sew across the bottom of the piece.

These are great to use to clean tumblers and wine glasses too.
